TITLE: CONCERNING A CLARIFICATION OF THE DEFINITION OF VETERINARY PREMISES IN THE "COLORADO VETERINARY PRACTICE ACT".**Summary of Legislation**

Current law defines the term "veterinary premises" under the Colorado Veterinary Practices Act to mean a veterinary office or other location in which veterinary medicine is practiced by, or under the direct or immediate supervision of, a licensed veterinarian. The bill expands this definition to include a place where veterinary medicine is practiced under the direction and supervision of a licensed veterinarian. The change means that a licensed veterinarian could be, but is not required to be, on the premises when a patient is being treated.

Assessment

The bill will not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state agency and, as such, is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
