Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$739,591 General Fund and 6.0 FTE to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2013-14. This appropriation corresponds to the appropriation indicated in the Revised Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated February 28, 2013 and is consistent with the bill, as amended.

Points to Consider

GF Expenditures

The Joint Budget Committee introduced a budget package for FY 2013-14 based on the March 2013 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package appropriates all but approximately \$8.0 million of General Fund revenues projected to be available, less a statutorily required five percent General Fund reserve. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$739,591 for FY 2013-14.
