Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill does not include an appropriation clause for FY 2013-14, and one is not required if the bill is enacted prior to the introduction of the FY 2013-14 Long Bill. If the bill is not enacted prior to the introduction of the FY 2013-14 Long Bill, it will require an appropriation clause transferring to the Department of Human Services the Early Childhood Leadership Council from the Governor's Office, and the following programs from the Department of Public Health and Environment:

- the Nurse Home Visitation Program;
- the Tony Grampsas Youth Services Program;
- the Colorado Student Dropout Prevention and Intervention Program;
- the Colorado Before-and-After School Project;
- the Colorado Children's Trust Fund and its board; and
- the Family Resource Center Program.
