Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee introduced a budget package for FY 2013-14 based on the March 2013 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package appropriates all but approximately \$8.0 million of General Fund revenues projected to be available, less a statutorily required five percent General Fund reserve. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$8,035 for FY 2013-14.
