- **J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add the following appropriations in FY 2013-14:
  - increases \$1,173,976 cash funds from the Disability Investigational and Support Fund to the Department of Personnel; and
  - Reduces \$164,195 total funds, including \$82,969 cash funds from the Coordinated Care for People with Disabilities Fund and \$82,969 federal funds from the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing, and increases \$1,743 cash funds from various sources for indirect cost recoveries.
