101	CONCERNING A STATEWIDE AUTOMATED VICTIM INFORMATION
102	NOTIFICATION SYSTEM, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH
103	MAKING AND REDUCING APPROPRIATIONS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill authorizes the general assembly to appropriate, and directs the division of criminal justice in the department of public safety to distribute, moneys for a statewide victim information and notification system.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-33.5-514 as
3	follows:
4	24-33.5-514. Statewide automated victim information and
5	notification system - legislative declaration. (1) The General
6	ASSEMBLY HEREBY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT:
7	(a) THE FEDERAL DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE OFFERED GRANTS TO
8	HELP ESTABLISH STATEWIDE AUTOMATED VICTIM INFORMATION AND
9	NOTIFICATION SYSTEMS;
10	(b) A COLORADO STATEWIDE ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY SHERIFFS
11	APPLIED FOR AND RECEIVED GRANTS TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE
12	AUTOMATED VICTIM INFORMATION AND NOTIFICATION SYSTEM AND
13	RECENTLY RECEIVED AN ADDITIONAL GRANT TO UPGRADE THE SYSTEM;
14	(c) THE SYSTEM ALLOWS CRIME VICTIMS AND OTHER CONCERNED
15	CITIZENS TO ACCESS TIMELY AND RELIABLE INFORMATION ABOUT
16	CRIMINAL CASES AND THE CUSTODY STATUS OF OFFENDERS TWENTY-FOUR
17	HOURS A DAY OVER THE TELEPHONE, THROUGH THE INTERNET, OR BY
18	ELECTRONIC MAIL;
19	(d) THE SYSTEM IS AVAILABLE FOR ANY COUNTY THAT WISHES TO
20	PARTICIPATE AND ALSO INCLUDES THE DIVISION OF YOUTH CORRECTIONS;
21	(e) Although the federal grants were sufficient to
22	ESTABLISH THE SYSTEM, THERE IS NO FUNDING SOURCE FOR THE ONGOING
23	EXPENSES OF OPERATING THE SYSTEM; AND
24	(f) THE DIVISION IS IN THE BEST POSITION TO DISTRIBUTE FUNDING
25	FOR THE SYSTEM AND TO MONITOR ITS EFFECTIVENESS.
26	(2) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY ANNUALLY APPROPRIATE FROM

1	THE GENERAL FUND TO THE DIVISION MONEYS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE
2	STATEWIDE AUTOMATED VICTIM INFORMATION AND NOTIFICATION
3	SYSTEM. THE DIVISION MUST DISTRIBUTE MONEYS APPROPRIATED TO THE
4	DIVISION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE OPERATION OF THE
5	STATEWIDE AUTOMATED VICTIM INFORMATION AND NOTIFICATION SYSTEM
6	TO BE USED BY THE COUNTY SHERIFFS, THE DIVISION OF YOUTH
7	CORRECTIONS, AND OTHER DEPARTMENTS OR AGENCIES.
8	SECTION 2. Appropriation. (1) In addition to any other
9	appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
10	general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of public
11	safety, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$434,720, or
12	so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the division of
13	criminal justice, victims assistance, for the statewide automated victim
14	information and notification system created by this act.
15	(2) For the implementation of this act, appropriations made in the
16	annual general appropriation act to the department of human services,
17	division of youth corrections, institutional programs, for operating
18	expenses, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, are adjusted as
19	follows:
20	(a) The general fund appropriation is decreased by \$10,000.
21	(b) The reappropriated funds appropriation is increased by
22	\$10,000. Said sum is from reappropriated funds received from the
23	department of public safety out of the appropriation made in subsection
24	(1) of this section.
25	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
26	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
