## **Summary of Legislation**

The bill eliminates certain statutory restrictions on bingo games. Specifically, the bill does the following:

- removes the annual limit on bingo occasions (currently, 35 occasions per year); and
- allows bingo to be played solely using an electronic device.

## **State Expenditures**

The bill requires the Secretary of State to make changes in bingo regulations. The workload required to make these changes is minimal and can be accomplished within existing appropriations to the Secretary of State.
