The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause for FY 2013-14.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

- **J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating the following amounts to the Department of Natural Resources from the Oil and Gas Conservation and Environmental Response Fund for FY 2013-14:
  - \$66,290 cash funds and 1.5 FTE for personal services;
  - \$15,130 cash funds for operating expenses and to support board meeting costs; and
  - \$75,705 cash funds for the purchase of legal services.

Amendment J.001 also provides \$75,705 reappropriated funds and 0.6 FTE to the Department of Law for additional legal services provided to the Department of Natural Resources in FY 2013-14 associated with the implementation of the bill.
