Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause for FY 2013-14. The bill alters the limited gaming tax revenue transfer levels to six existing funds subject to annual appropriations. For purposes of this fiscal analysis, staff assumes that this bill will pass prior to the introduction of the FY 2013-14 Long Bill (March 25) and the FY 2013-14 Long Bill will include the appropriations authorized by this bill. If this bill does not pass prior to the Long Bill introduction, the Long Bill will include current law appropriation levels from the six funds and this bill will require an appropriation clause that adjusts these six Long Bill appropriations.
