Bill Summary

The bill enlarges the board of directors of the statewide internet portal authority from 13 to 15 members by adding a member who is appointed by the minority leader in the senate and a member who is appointed by the minority leader in the house of representatives. The bill

HOUSE 2nd Reading Unamended May 2, 2013 also specifies when the appointments are to be made and when the terms of the new board members begin and end.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-37.7-102, amend 3 (2) introductory portion, (2) (f), and (5) (b) as follows: 4 24-37.7-102. Statewide internet portal authority - creation -5 **board.** (2) The governing body of the authority shall be a board of 6 directors that shall consist of the following thirteen FIFTEEN voting 7 members: 8 (f) One member TWO MEMBERS of the senate, ONE OF WHOM IS 9 appointed by the president of the senate and one member ONE OF WHOM 10 IS APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE AND TWO 11 MEMBERS of the house of representatives, ONE OF WHOM IS appointed by 12 the speaker of the house of representatives both of whom AND ONE OF 13 WHOM IS APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF 14 REPRESENTATIVES. EACH OF THESE FOUR MEMBERS shall exhibit a 15 background in information management and technology or who have 16 experience as members of an oversight committee for information 17 management and technology. THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MEMBERS TO THE 18 BOARD BY THE MINORITY LEADERS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF 19 REPRESENTATIVES SHALL BE MADE AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER THE 20 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS PARAGRAPH (f), AS AMENDED. 21 (5) (b) The terms of the members appointed by the speaker of the 22 house of representatives and the president of the senate and who are 23 serving on March 22, 2007, shall be extended to and THE EFFECTIVE DATE 24 OF THIS SUBSECTION (5), AS AMENDED, ARE EXTENDED TO AND expire on 25 or shall terminate on the convening date of the first regular session of the

sixty-seventh SEVENTIETH general assembly. THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS
INITIALLY APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADERS OF THE SENATE AND
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES EXPIRE OR TERMINATE ON THE CONVENING
DATE OF THE FIRST REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTIETH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY. As soon as practicable after such convening date, the speaker,
and the president, AND THE MINORITY LEADERS shall each appoint or
reappoint one member in the same manner as provided in paragraph (f)
of subsection (2) of this section. Thereafter, the terms of members
appointed or reappointed by the speaker, and the president, AND THE
MINORITY LEADERS shall expire on the convening date of the first regular
session of each general assembly, and all subsequent appointments and
reappointments by the speaker, and the president, AND THE MINORITY
LEADERS shall be made as soon as practicable after such convening date.
Members appointed or reappointed by the speaker, and the president, AND
THE MINORITY LEADERS shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing
authority and shall continue in office until the member's successor is
appointed.
SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
