**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING LIMITATIONS ON DRUG PARAPHERNALIA LAWS.**

**Bill Summary**

Current law exempts from the statutes dealing with drug paraphernalia persons participating as an employee or volunteer of a syringe exchange program approved by the department of public health and environment. The bill extends this exemption to persons who are participants in an approved program.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 18-18-430.5  
3 as follows:

4 **18-18-430.5. Drug paraphernalia - exemption.** A person shall  
5 be exempt from the provisions of sections 18-18-425 to 18-18-430 if he  
6 or she is participating as an employee, ~~or~~ volunteer, OR PARTICIPANT in  
7 an approved syringe exchange program created pursuant to section  
8 25-1-520, C.R.S.

9 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
11 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
