A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A NAVY SEAL LICENSE PLATE, AND,**
102 **IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill creates the Navy SEAL license plate. A person must demonstrate being a Navy SEAL by submitting a DD214 and certification from the UDT-SEAL association, inc. In addition to the normal motor vehicle fees, the plate requires 2 one-time fees of \$25. One of the fees is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other to the licensing

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-213, **add** (1) (a)
3 (XXV) and (26) as follows:

4 **42-3-213. Special plates - military veterans - rules - retirement.**

5 (1) (a) The department shall issue one or more sets of special license
6 plates to the following persons who own a truck that does not exceed
7 sixteen thousand pounds empty weight, a passenger car, a motorcycle, or
8 a noncommercial or recreational vehicle:

9 (XXV) AN HONORABLY DISCHARGED, RETIRED, RESERVE, OR
10 ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE NAVY SEALS.

11 (26) **Honorably discharged, retired veteran, or active member**
12 **of the Navy SEALs.** (a) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGN THE NAVY
13 SEAL LICENSE PLATE TO INDICATE THAT AN OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE
14 TO WHICH THE PLATE IS ATTACHED IS A VETERAN, A RESERVE MEMBER, OR
15 AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY SEALS.

16 (b) A NATURAL PERSON WHO HAS RECEIVED AN HONORABLE
17 DISCHARGE, IS RETIRED, OR IS AN ACTIVE OR RESERVE MEMBER OF THE
18 UNITED STATES NAVY SEALS MAY USE A UNITED STATES NAVY SEALS
19 LICENSE PLATE. TO QUALIFY FOR THE LICENSE PLATE, AN APPLICANT MUST
20 SUBMIT A DD214 FORM ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT AND
21 A CERTIFICATION FROM THE UDT/SEAL ASSOCIATION, INC., THE ROCKY
22 MOUNTAIN CHAPTER OF THE UDT/SEAL ASSOCIATION, INC., OR A
23 SUCCESSOR ORGANIZATION, THAT THE APPLICANT HAS AN HONORABLE
24 DISCHARGE FROM, IS RETIRED FROM, OR IS CURRENTLY AN ACTIVE OR
25 RESERVE MEMBER OF THE NAVY SEALS.

1 **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
2 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
3 license plate cash fund created in section 42-3-301 (1) (b), Colorado
4 Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of
5 revenue, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$355, or
6 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be allocated to the division of
7 motor vehicles for the purchase of special license plates related to this act.

8 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
9 appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado state titling and
10 registration account in the highway users tax fund created in section
11 42-1-211 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to
12 the department of revenue, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the
13 sum of 2,960, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be allocated to
14 the information technology division for the purchase of computer center
15 services related to this act.

16 (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
17 appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and
18 budgeting, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$2,960,
19 or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the office of
20 information technology, for the provision of computer center services for
21 the department of revenue related to the implementation of this act. Said
22 sum is from reappropriated funds received from the department of
23 revenue out of the appropriation made in subsection (2) of this section.

24 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
25 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
26 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
27 general assembly (August 7, 2013, if adjournment sine die is on May 8,

1 2013); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
2 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
3 or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
4 will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
5 to be held in November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the
6 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

7 (2) This act applies to license plate applications issued on or after
8 the January 1, 2014.
