1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-30-2114, **repeal**

3 (4) (c) as follows:

4 **24-30-2114. Surcharge - collection and distribution - address**
5 **confidentiality program surcharge fund - creation - definitions.**

6 (4) (c) ~~No general fund moneys shall be appropriated for the purpose of~~
7 ~~implementing the address confidentiality program.~~

8 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
9 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
