## **A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 CONCERNING PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR SCHOOL 102

ACTIVITIES BY STUDENTS ENROLLED IN NONPUBLIC HOME-BASED

103 **EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS.** 

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under the bill, a school district, a public school, or an interscholastic organization cannot require a student who is enrolled in a nonpublic home-based educational program to enroll in or complete course credits as a condition of participating in an extracurricular activity, unless the activity is an extension of a course. The bill clarifies that the statute that governs a student's ability to enroll in a program or school other than the student's neighborhood school does not apply to student participation in extracurricular activities at a public school.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-33-104.5, amend 3 (6) (b) (I) as follows: 4 22-33-104.5. Home-based education - legislative declaration -5 **definitions - guidelines.** (6) (b) (I) For purposes of this subsection (6), 6 a child who is participating in a nonpublic home-based educational 7 program shall have HAS the same rights as a student enrolled in a public 8 school of the school district in which the child resides or is enrolled and 9 may participate on an equal basis in any extracurricular or interscholastic 10 activity offered by a public school or offered by a private school, at the 11 private school's discretion, as provided in section 22-32-116.5 and is 12 subject to the same rules of any interscholastic organization or association 13 of which the student's school of participation is a member. A SCHOOL 14 DISTRICT, A PUBLIC SCHOOL, OR AN INTERSCHOLASTIC ORGANIZATION OR 15 ASSOCIATION SHALL NOT REQUIRE A CHILD WHO IS PARTICIPATING IN A 16 NONPUBLIC HOME-BASED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO ENROLL IN A 17 COURSE OR TO COMPLETE ANY COURSE CREDITS AS AN ELIGIBILITY 18 REQUIREMENT OR OTHER CONDITION FOR PARTICIPATION IN AN 19 EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY; EXCEPT THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, PUBLIC 20 SCHOOL, OR INTERSCHOLASTIC ORGANIZATION MAY REQUIRE THE STUDENT 21 TO ENROLL IN A COURSE IF THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY IS AN 22 EXTENSION OF THE COURSE, SUCH AS A PERFORMING ARTS GROUP. 23 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-32-116.5, add (4)

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1 (c) as follows:

2 22-32-116.5. Extracurricular and interscholastic activities. 3 (4) (c) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBSECTION (4) TO 4 THE CONTRARY, A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL NOT 5 REQUIRE A STUDENT WHO IS PARTICIPATING IN A NONPUBLIC HOME-BASED 6 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO ENROLL IN A COURSE OR TO COMPLETE ANY 7 COURSE CREDITS AS AN ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT OR OTHER CONDITION 8 FOR PARTICIPATION IN AN ACTIVITY; EXCEPT THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT 9 OR PUBLIC SCHOOL MAY REQUIRE THE STUDENT TO ENROLL IN A COURSE 10 IF THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY IS AN EXTENSION OF THE COURSE, 11 SUCH AS A PERFORMING ARTS GROUP.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-36-101, add (6)
as follows:

14 22-36-101. Choice of programs and schools within school 15 districts. (6) The provisions of this section do not apply to 16 STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES OFFERED BY 17 A PUBLIC SCHOOL OF THE STUDENT'S DISTRICT OF RESIDENCE OR BY A 18 PUBLIC SCHOOL OF ANOTHER DISTRICT OR BY AN INSTITUTE CHARTER 19 SCHOOL. STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES IS 20 GOVERNED BY SECTION 22-32-116.5 AND BY SECTION 22-33-104.5 FOR 21 STUDENTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN NONPUBLIC HOME-BASED EDUCATIONAL 22 PROGRAMS.

23 SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
24 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
25 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
