A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE LIMITATION ON THE AMOUNT OF
102	DAMAGES THAT MAY BE RECOVERED BY AN INJURED PARTY
103	UNDER THE "COLORADO GOVERNMENTAL IMMUNITY ACT".

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Currently, the "Colorado Governmental Immunity Act" (act) sets as a maximum amount that may be recovered by a person suing a public entity or public employee for loss or injury caused by the entity or employee in any single occurrence, whether from one or more public

SENATE Amended 2nd Reading March 5, 2013 entities and public employees:

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- ! For any injury to one person in any single occurrence, the sum of \$150,000; and
- ! For an injury to 2 or more persons in any single occurrence, the sum of \$600,000, and, in such circumstances, the act prohibits any single person from recovering in excess of \$150,000.

To ensure these limitations on damages reflect the effects of inflation since the specific limitations were last increased by the general assembly, the bill increases the damages limitation for any injury to one person in any single occurrence to \$478,000. For an injury to 2 or more persons in any single occurrence, the bill increases the damages limitation to \$990,000 and further specifies that, in such circumstances, a single person is precluded from recovering in excess of \$478,000.

The bill further provides that the increased damages amounts are:

- ! Exclusive of interest awarded; and
- ! Adjusted for inflation every 4 years. The bill requires the attorney general to make this required adjustment on an every 4-year basis commencing January 1, 2018, to certify the amount of the adjustment, and to publish the amount of the adjustment on the attorney general's web site.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-10-114, **amend** 3 (1) as follows:
 - **24-10-114.** Limitations on judgments recommendation to general assembly authorization of additional payment. (1) The maximum amount that may be recovered under this article in any single occurrence, whether from one or more public entities and public employees, shall be:
 - (a) For any injury to one person in any single occurrence, the sum of one hundred fifty thousand THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND dollars;
 - (b) For an injury to two or more persons in any single occurrence, the sum of six hundred thousand NINE HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND dollars; except that, in such instance, no person may recover in excess of

2	(c) THE AMOUNTS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTIONS (a) AND (b) OF THIS
3	SUBSECTION (1) SHALL BE ADJUSTED BY AN AMOUNT REFLECTING THE
4	PERCENTAGE CHANGE OVER A FOUR-YEAR PERIOD IN THE UNITED STATES
5	DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS, CONSUMER PRICE
6	INDEX FOR DENVER-BOULDER-GREELEY, ALL ITEMS, ALL URBAN
7	CONSUMERS, OR ITS SUCCESSOR INDEX. ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2018,
8	AND BY JANUARY 1 EVERY FOURTH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE $\underline{\text{SECRETARY}}$
9	OF STATE SHALL CALCULATE THE ADJUSTED DOLLAR AMOUNT FOR THE
10	IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FOUR-YEAR PERIOD AS OF THE DATE OF THE
11	CALCULATION. THE ADJUSTED AMOUNT SHALL BE ROUNDED UPWARD TO
12	THE NEAREST ONE THOUSAND DOLLAR INCREMENT. THE <u>SECRETARY OF</u>
13	STATE SHALL CERTIFY THE AMOUNT OF THE ADJUSTMENT FOR THE
14	PARTICULAR FOUR-YEAR PERIOD AND SHALL PUBLISH THE AMOUNT OF THE
15	ADJUSTMENT ON THE <u>SECRETARY OF STATE'S</u> WEB SITE.
16	SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act takes effect
17	July 1, 2013, and applies to <u>injuries occurring</u> on or after said date.
18	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
19	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
20	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
