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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING TRANSFERS OF MONEYS RELATED TO CAPITAL**  
102 **CONSTRUCTION.**

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**Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** For the 2012-13 fiscal year, the bill increases the transfer from the general fund to the capital construction fund from \$60,491,314 to \$60,911,498.

For the 2013-14 fiscal year, the bill transfers \$192,566,495 from the general fund to the capital construction fund and \$500,000 from the

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-302, **amend**  
3 (2) introductory portion, (2) (y), (2.5) introductory portion, (2.5) (f), and  
4 (2.5) (g); and **add** (2) (z) and (2.5) (h) as follows:

5           **24-75-302. Capital construction fund - capital assessment fees**  
6 **- calculation.** (2) On July 1 of each year through ~~July 1, 2012~~ JULY 1,  
7 2013, the state treasurer and the controller shall transfer a sum as  
8 specified in this subsection (2) out of the general fund and into the capital  
9 construction fund as moneys become available in the general fund during  
10 the fiscal year beginning on said July 1. Transfers between funds pursuant  
11 to this subsection (2) are not appropriations subject to the limitations of  
12 section 24-75-201.1. The amounts transferred pursuant to this subsection  
13 (2) are as follows:

14           (y) On July 1, 2012, ~~fifty-nine million nine hundred nineteen~~  
15 ~~thousand three hundred nine~~ SIXTY MILLION THREE HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE  
16 THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-THREE dollars, plus one hundred  
17 twelve thousand six hundred forty-nine dollars pursuant to H.B. 08-1115,  
18 enacted at the second regular session of the sixty-sixth general assembly;  
19 plus three hundred seventy-five thousand four hundred ninety-five dollars  
20 pursuant to S.B. 08-239, enacted at the second regular session of the  
21 sixty-sixth general assembly; plus eighty-three thousand eight hundred  
22 sixty-one dollars pursuant to S.B. 10-128, enacted at the second regular  
23 session of the sixty-seventh general assembly.

24           (z) ON JULY 1, 2013, ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX MILLION TWO  
25 HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-THREE DOLLARS.

1 (2.5) In addition to the sums accrued pursuant to subsection (2) of  
2 this section, on July 1 of each year through ~~July 1, 2012~~ JULY 1, 2013, the  
3 state treasurer and the controller shall transfer a sum as specified in this  
4 subsection (2.5) from the general fund exempt account of the general  
5 fund created pursuant to section 24-77-103.6 to the capital construction  
6 fund as moneys become available in the general fund exempt account  
7 during the fiscal year beginning on said July 1. Transfers between funds  
8 pursuant to this subsection (2.5) are not appropriations subject to the  
9 limitations of section 24-75-201.1. The amounts transferred pursuant to  
10 this subsection (2.5) are as follows:

11 (f) On July 1, 2011, five hundred thousand dollars; ~~and~~

12 (g) On July 1, 2012, five hundred thousand dollars; AND

13 (h) ON JULY 1, 2013, FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS.

14 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 24-75-222 as  
15 follows:

16 **24-75-222. Transfer of general fund surplus to Colorado water**  
17 **conservation board construction fund - repeal.** (1) NOTWITHSTANDING  
18 ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ON THE DATE ON WHICH THE  
19 STATE CONTROLLER PUBLISHES THE COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL FINANCIAL  
20 REPORT OF THE STATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2013-14, THE STATE  
21 TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER TO THE COLORADO WATER CONSERVATION  
22 BOARD CONSTRUCTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 37-60-121, C.R.S., UP  
23 TO THIRTY MILLION DOLLARS OF THE GENERAL FUND SURPLUS DESIGNATED  
24 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 24-75-201 (1) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
25 2013-14, WHICH REPRESENTS THE UNRESTRICTED GENERAL FUND  
26 BALANCE AFTER THE APPLICABLE AMOUNT OF RESERVE REQUIRED  
27 PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-75-201.1 (1) (d) IS RETAINED.

1 (2) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015.

2 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47.1-1201, **repeal**  
3 **(5) (c) (III) (C).**

4 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47.1-1201,  
5 **amend (5) (c) (III) (E) as follows:**

6 **12-47.1-1201. State historical fund - administration -**  
7 **legislative declaration - state museum cash fund - capitol dome**  
8 **restoration fund.** (5) (c) (III) (E) Prior to the end of the 2014-15 state  
9 fiscal year and after a complete accounting is available of the total in-kind  
10 and monetary donations received through the fundraising program  
11 established in section 2-3-1304.3, C.R.S., an end-of-project accounting  
12 shall occur based on the final total cost of the dome restoration  
13 construction project to ensure, through the annual general appropriations  
14 act, supplemental appropriations acts, or transfers between funds, as  
15 necessary, that all of the transfers from the state historical fund specified  
16 in sub-subparagraphs (A), (B), and (C) (A) AND (B) of this subparagraph  
17 (III), AND THE 2013-14 APPROPRIATION FROM THE CAPITAL  
18 CONSTRUCTION FUND SPECIFIED IN SENATE BILL 13-230, are reduced,  
19 dollar for dollar, by the combined total of moneys deposited into the  
20 capitol dome restoration trust fund as specified in section 2-3-1304.3 (6)  
21 (b), C.R.S., grants for repairs and safety improvements to the state capitol  
22 dome and supporting structures made by the state historical society under  
23 the grants process set forth in subsection (1) of this section, any money  
24 received for the recycling of salvaged building materials from the state  
25 capitol dome during the construction period, and any in-kind gifts and  
26 donations, such as materials or labor, that resulted in the reduction of the  
27 total cost of the construction. The total value of any in-kind gifts and

1 donations for purposes of the dollar-for-dollar reduction specified in this  
2 sub-subparagraph (E) shall be calculated by the department of personnel  
3 and approved by the capital development committee as specified in  
4 section 2-3-1304.3 (6) (a) (II), C.R.S.

5 **SECTION 5. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
6 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
7 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
