## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE ELIMINATION OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT A
 102 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION PROVIDE CERTAIN REPORTS ON AN
 103 ANNUAL BASIS.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Currently, every political subdivision in the state is required to file an annual report with the division of local government (division) in the department of local affairs that lists the current contracts in effect with other political subdivisions. The bill eliminates the requirement to file the lists annually and instead requires a political subdivision to provide such list within 30 days of receiving a written request to do so from the division.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 29-1-205 as
3 follows:

4 29-1-205. List of contracts. On or before February 1 of each 5 year, each WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER RECEIVING A WRITTEN REQUEST 6 FROM THE DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, A political subdivision shall 7 file with PROVIDE the division of local government an updated 8 informational WITH A CURRENT list of all contracts in effect with other 9 political subdivisions. Said THE list shall MUST contain the names of the 10 contracting political subdivisions, the nature of the contract, and the 11 expiration date thereof. Within ten days after the execution of a contract 12 establishing a separate governmental entity pursuant to section 29-1-204, 13 or an amendment or a modification thereof. THE CONTRACTING LOCAL 14 GOVERNMENTS SHALL FILE a copy of such contract, amendment, or 15 modification shall be filed with the division. of local government. Failure 16 to make any filing under this section shall DOES not invalidate any 17 contract referred to in this section.

**SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 7, 2013, if adjournment sine die is on May 8, 2013); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
