Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$3,860,429 from the general fund to the Colorado state veterans





trust fund. This transfer repays moneys expended from the trust fund for construction projects to build National Guard armories at Alamosa, Grand Junction, and Windsor.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 28-5-709, add (3.5) 3 (c) as follows: 4 28-5-709. Colorado state veterans trust fund - created - report. 5 (3.5) (c) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION TO THE 6 CONTRARY, ON JULY 1, 2013, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DEDUCT 7 THREE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED 8 TWENTY-NINE DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND AND TRANSFER SUCH 9 SUM TO THE COLORADO STATE VETERANS TRUST FUND. SUCH AMOUNT 10 SHALL BE RETAINED AS PRINCIPAL IN THE TRUST FUND, AND ANY INTEREST 11 EARNED ON THE PRINCIPAL SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATION 12 BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND MAY BE ALLOCATED BY THE BOARD FOR 13 THE PURPOSES OUTLINED IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION. 14 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 15 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
