101	CONCERNING THE PERFORMANCE OF AURICULAR ACUDETOX BY
102	TRAINED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS, AND, IN
103	CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

The bill allows a licensed, registered, or certified mental health care professional, who has been appropriately trained, to perform auricular acudetox. The auricular acudetox must be performed within the health care professional's current scope of practice.

13	WHO IS CERTIFIED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE AND WHO HAS PROVIDED
14	DOCUMENTATION THAT HE OR SHE HAS BEEN TRAINED TO PERFORM
15	AURICULAR ACUDETOX IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS

5	SECTION 5 . Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
5	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
7	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
