

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill allows a licensed, registered, or certified mental health care professional, who has been appropriately trained, to perform auricular acudetox. The auricular acudetox must be performed within the health care professional's current scope of practice.

4 Unlawful acts - exceptions - definition. 12-29.5-105. 5 (3) (a) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE TO THE CONTRARY, A MENTAL HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL WHO IS <u>LICENSED</u> 6 7 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 43 OF THIS TITLE AND A CERTIFIED ADDICTION 8 COUNSELOR III WHO IS CERTIFIED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 43 OF THIS TITLE 9 AND WHO HAS PROVIDED DOCUMENTATION THAT HE OR SHE HAS BEEN 10 TRAINED TO PERFORM AURICULAR ACUDETOX IN COMPLIANCE WITH 11 PARAGRAPH (d) OF THIS SUBSECTION (3) MAY PERFORM AURICULAR 12 ACUDETOX.  <u>funds received from the department of regulatory agencies out of the</u>
 <u>appropriation made in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section.</u>
 SECTION <u>4.</u> Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2013.
 SECTION <u>5.</u> Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
