A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE PERFORMANCE OF AURICULAR ACUDETOX BY
102	TRAINED MENTAL HEALTH <u>PROFESSIONALS, AND, IN</u>
103	CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill allows a licensed, registered, or certified mental health care professional, who has been appropriately trained, to perform auricular acudetox. The auricular acudetox must be performed within the health care professional's current scope of practice. 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
