**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101     **CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF JUDGES IN CERTAIN**  
102             **JUDICIAL DISTRICTS.**

**Bill Summary**

The bill increases the number of judges in the 5th judicial district from 5 to 6 and in the 9th judicial district from 4 to 5.

1     *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-5-106, **amend** (2)  
2 (a); and **repeal** (2) (b) and (2) (c) as follows:

3           **13-5-106. Fifth district.** (2) (a) The number of judges for the  
4 fifth judicial district shall be ~~three~~ SIX.

5           (b) ~~Subject to available appropriations, effective July 1, 2002, the~~  
6 ~~number of judges for the fifth judicial district shall be four.~~

7           (c) ~~Subject to available appropriations, effective July 1, 2004, the~~  
8 ~~number of judges for the fifth judicial district shall be five.~~

9           **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-5-110, **amend** (2)  
10 as follows:

11           **13-5-110. Ninth district.** (2) (a) The number of judges for the  
12 ninth judicial district shall be ~~three~~ FIVE.

13           (b) ~~Subject to available appropriations, effective July 1, 2008, the~~  
14 ~~number of judges for the ninth judicial district shall be four.~~

15           **SECTION 3. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2013.

16           **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
