A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF JUDGES IN CERTAIN JUDICIAL DISTRICTS.

Bill Summary

The bill increases the number of judges in the 5th judicial district from 5 to 6 and in the 9th judicial district from 4 to 5.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-5-106, amend (2)
2	(a); and repeal (2) (b) and (2) (c) as follows:
3	13-5-106. Fifth district. (2) (a) The number of judges for the
4	fifth judicial district shall be three SIX.
5	(b) Subject to available appropriations, effective July 1, 2002, the
6	number of judges for the fifth judicial district shall be four.
7	(c) Subject to available appropriations, effective July 1, 2004, the
8	number of judges for the fifth judicial district shall be five.
9	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-5-110, amend (2)
10	as follows:
11	13-5-110. Ninth district. (2) (a) The number of judges for the
12	ninth judicial district shall be three FIVE.
13	(b) Subject to available appropriations, effective July 1, 2008, the
14	number of judges for the ninth judicial district shall be four.
15	SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2013.
16	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
17	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
