A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING COLLECTION OF RESTITUTION ORDERED PURSUANT TO A  
102 DEFERRED JUDGMENT.

Bill Summary

The bill clarifies that an order of restitution that is part of a deferred judgment can be collected by the court after the deferred judgment is dismissed until the judgment is satisfied.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-1.3-603, **amend**

3 (4) (a) as follows:

4 **18-1.3-603. Assessment of restitution - corrective orders.**

5 (4) (a) Any order for restitution entered pursuant to this section ~~shall be~~  
6 OR AS A CONDITION OF A DEFERRED SENTENCE IS a final civil judgment in  
7 favor of the state and any victim. Notwithstanding any other civil or  
8 criminal statute or rule, any such judgment ~~shall remain~~ REMAINS in force  
9 until the restitution is paid in full AND MAY BE COLLECTED BY THE COURT  
10 OR A COLLECTIONS INVESTIGATOR IN THE SAME MANNER AS FINES, FEES,  
11 COST, SURCHARGES, OR OTHER MONETARY ASSESSMENTS AS SET FORTH IN  
12 16-11-101.6, C.R.S.

13 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
