**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING COLLECTION OF RESTITUTION ORDERED PURSUANT TO A**  
102 **DEFERRED JUDGMENT.**

**Bill Summary**

The bill clarifies that an order of restitution that is part of a deferred judgment can be collected by the court after the deferred judgment is dismissed until the judgment is satisfied.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 16-18.5-111 as  
3 follows:

4 **16-18.5-111. Effect of termination of deferred judgment and**  
5 **sentence or deferred adjudication.** THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE  
6 APPLY NOTWITHSTANDING THE TERMINATION OF A DEFERRED JUDGMENT  
7 AND SENTENCE OR A DEFERRED ADJUDICATION.

8 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-1.3-603, **amend**  
9 (4) (a) as follows:

10 **18-1.3-603. Assessment of restitution - corrective orders.**

11 (4) (a) Any order for restitution entered pursuant to this section shall be  
12 a final civil judgment in favor of the state and any victim.  
13 Notwithstanding any other civil or criminal statute or rule, any such  
14 judgment shall remain in force until the restitution is paid in full. THE  
15 PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 18.5 OF TITLE 16, C.R.S., APPLY  
16 NOTWITHSTANDING THE TERMINATION OF A DEFERRED JUDGMENT AND  
17 SENTENCE OR A DEFERRED ADJUDICATION.

18 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
19 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
20 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
