**Summary of Legislation**

This bill clarifies that emission inspection requirements continue to apply to a collector's item motor vehicle registered before September 1, 2009, until the vehicle is transferred to a new owner.

**Background**

House Bill 13-1071 allowed vehicles with a model year that is at least 32 years old to become a collector's item. The bill required a collector's item motor vehicle to pass an emissions test within 12 months of registration, if the vehicle is in the Enhanced Emissions Program (EEP) area. Currently, the EEP area for gas powered vehicles includes the entire counties of Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, and Jefferson, parts of Larimer and Weld counties, and those parts of Adams and Arapahoe counties that are west of Kiowa Creek. The EEP area for diesel powered vehicles includes the counties listed above, and in addition, includes parts of El Paso county.

**State Expenditures**

This bill is anticipated to increase workload and programming costs by a minimal amount for the Department of Revenue. The bill requires programming changes to be made to the Colorado State Titling and Registration System (CSTARS) and that training be provided to state and county office staff. Any activities associated with updating the CSTARS system and training staff are expected to be minimal and can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

**Effective Date**

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 7, 2014.
