A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING EXPANDING ACCESS FOR ALL STUDENTS TO COLORADO
102 STATE UNIVERSITY - GLOBAL CAMPUS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill amends the role and mission of Colorado state university global - campus on-line university to permit baccalaureate degree programs instead of upper-division baccalaureate completion degree programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 23-31.3-101
3 as follows:

4 **23-31.3-101. University established - role and mission.** There
5 is hereby established an on-line university to be known as Colorado state
6 university - global campus, referred to in this article as "CSU global
7 campus". CSU global campus is a baccalaureate and graduate on-line
8 university with the mission in Colorado of offering ~~upper-division~~
9 baccalaureate degree ~~completion~~ programs for nontraditional students in
10 partnership with the Colorado community college system and selected
11 master-level graduate programs. CSU global campus shall comply with
12 all applicable statutes and rules.

13 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
14 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
16 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a
17 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
18 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
19 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
20 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
21 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
22 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
