The bill includes a provision appropriating \$39,436 cash funds from the Public Utilities Commission Fixed Utility Fund and 0.3 FTE to the Department of Regulatory Agencies and reappropriating \$18,216 and 0.1 FTE to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services for FY 2014-15.
