

**UPDATED SUMMARY  
HOUSE BILL 14-1118**

**Second Regular Session - Sixty-ninth Colorado General Assembly**

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*This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.*

The bill creates the advanced placement incentives pilot program (pilot program) in the department of education. If a school district is determined by the department of education to be rural ~~or small~~, a school within that rural ~~or small~~ school district is eligible to participate in the pilot program. The pilot program is annually limited to the first ~~10,000~~ 950 students from participating schools. The participating schools, as well as the teachers for advanced placement classes or mentors for advanced placement on-line classes, are eligible to receive bonuses through the pilot program for the number of students who successfully complete an advanced placement class and ~~for the number of students who~~ *subsequently* take ~~an~~ *the* advanced placement exam. The pilot program is repealed after 4 years.
