SHORT TITLE: UPDATE MORTALITY TABLE CIVIL ACTIONS

Summary of Legislation

This bill requires courts in civil actions to accept into evidence the most recent U.S. Census Bureau expectation of life and expected deaths by race, sex, and age table when considering a person's life expectancy. In addition, the bill repeals the mortality table included in Colorado law.

Assessment

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill simply changes the source for the courts to reference when calculating life expectancy. This change is not expected to affect revenue or expenditures for any state agencies or local governments.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 20, 2014 and takes effect August 6, 2014, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
