

**UPDATED SUMMARY  
SENATE BILL 14-048**

**Second Regular Session - Sixty-ninth Colorado General Assembly**

*This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.*

Section 1 of the bill requires courts to accept into evidence the most recent United States census bureau expectation of life and expected deaths by race, sex, and age table, as published by the United States census bureau, to establish the continued life expectancy of any person in a civil action in Colorado. Section 2 of the bill repeals Colorado's preexisting mortality table.
