**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$215,000 from the Transportation Network Company Fund created by the bill in Section 40-10.1-607, C.R.S, and reappropriates \$9,108 and 0.1 FTE to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services. Due to amendments adopted by the House Transportation and Energy Committee, the appropriation clause no longer reflects the required appropriation of the bill.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.006** Staff has prepared amendment **J.006** (attached) to updated the initial appropriation with one consistent with the Revised Fiscal Note. The new provision appropriates \$179,777 and 2.5 FTE from the Transportation Network Company Fund created in Section 40-10.1-607, C.R.S., and reappropriates \$9,108 and 0.1 FTE to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services.
