After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB14-125 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 8, line 24, strike "AND".
- 2 Page 8, line 27, strike "RIDE." and substitute "RIDE; AND
- 3 (IV) THE DRIVER'S FIRST NAME AND TELEPHONE NUMBER."
- 4 Page 9, lines 9 and 10, strike "FOR MORE THAN TWELVE CONSECUTIVE
- 5 HOURS" and substitute "IN EXCESS OF THE MAXIMUM SERVICE HOURS AS
- 6 DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION."
- 7 Page 10, after line 23, insert:
 - 8 (i) A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY SHALL MAKE THE
 - 9 FOLLOWING DISCLOSURE TO A PROSPECTIVE DRIVER IN THE PROSPECTIVE
 - 10 DRIVER'S TERMS OF SERVICE:
11 WHILE OPERATING ON THE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK
12 COMPANY'S DIGITAL NETWORK, YOUR PERSONAL
13 AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE POLICY MIGHT NOT AFFORD
14 LIABILITY COVERAGE, DEPENDING ON THE POLICY'S
15 TERMS.
 - 16 (j) A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY SHALL MAKE
 - 17 AVAILABLE TO A RIDER A CUSTOMER SUPPORT TELEPHONE NUMBER ON ITS
 - 18 DIGITAL NETWORK OR WEB SITE FOR RIDER INQUIRIES.
 - 19 (k) A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY SHALL DISCLOSE TO
 - 20 A RIDER THE INFORMATION SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH (i) IN THIS

1 SUBSECTION (1) ABOUT THE DRIVER'S PERSONAL AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
2 POLICY."

3 Page 10, line 24, after "COMPANY" insert "OR A THIRD PARTY".

4 Page 10, line 25, strike "SIX" and substitute "FOURTEEN".

5 Page 11, strike lines 15 and 16 and substitute "DRIVER. IF THE CRIMINAL
6 HISTORY RECORD CHECK REVEALS THAT THE PERSON HAS EVER BEEN
7 CONVICTED OF OR PLED GUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE TO ANY OF THE
8 FOLLOWING FELONY OFFENSES, THE PERSON".

9 Page 12, line 6, strike "SIX MONTHS" and substitute "FIVE YEARS".

10 Page 12, after line 7 insert:

11 "(IV) A PERSON WHO HAS, WITHIN THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING
12 FIVE YEARS, BEEN CONVICTED OF OR PLED GUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE
13 TO A FELONY SHALL NOT SERVE AS A DRIVER."

14 Page 12, line 24, after "COMPANY" insert "OR A THIRD PARTY".

15 Page 12, line 27, strike "SIX MONTHS." and substitute "THREE YEARS."

16 Page 14, strike lines 1 and 2 and substitute "6, A TRANSPORTATION
17 NETWORK COMPANY IS SUBJECT TO THE COMMISSION'S AUTHORITY UNDER
18 SECTIONS 40-7-101, 40-7-112, 40-7-113, 40-7-115, AND 40-7-116."

19 Page 14, after line 4 insert:

20 "(6) THE COMMISSION MAY DENY AN APPLICATION UNDER THIS
21 PART 6 OR REFUSE TO RENEW THE PERMIT OF A TRANSPORTATION
22 NETWORK COMPANY BASED ON A DETERMINATION THAT THE
23 TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY HAS NOT SATISFIED A CIVIL
24 PENALTY ARISING OUT OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE OR ENFORCEMENT ACTION
25 BROUGHT BY THE COMMISSION."

26 Page 14, after line 20, insert:

27 "**SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-4-601, **amend**
28 (10) as follows:

1 **10-4-601. Definitions.** As used in this part 6, unless the context
2 otherwise requires:
3 (10) (a) "Policy" means an automobile insurance policy providing
4 coverage for all or any of the following coverages: Collision,
5 comprehensive, bodily injury liability, property damage liability, medical
6 payments, and uninsured motorist coverage, or a combination automobile
7 policy providing bodily injury liability, property damage liability, medical
8 payments, uninsured motorist, and physical damage coverage, delivered
9 or issued for delivery in this state, insuring a single individual, or husband
10 and wife, or family members residing in the same household, as named
11 insured, and under which the insured vehicles therein designated are of
12 the following types only:
13 (α) (I) A motor vehicle of the private passenger or station wagon
14 type that is not used as a public or livery conveyance for passengers nor
15 rented to others pursuant to the terms of a motor vehicle rental agreement;
16 or
17 (β) (II) Any other four-wheel motor vehicle with a load capacity
18 of fifteen hundred pounds or less that is not used in the occupation,
19 profession, or business of the insured.
20 (b) AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION (10), "LIVERY CONVEYANCE"
21 DOES NOT MEAN THE SERVICES OFFERED BY A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK
22 COMPANY DRIVER, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 40-10.1-602 (4),
23 C.R.S., UNLESS THE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY DRIVER IS
24 ENGAGED IN A PREARRANGED RIDE, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION
25 40-10.1-602 (2), C.R.S."
