The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$4,120 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund to the Department of Revenue, Information Technology Division for FY 2014-15 to reprogram the Department's computer systems to implement the bill and reappropriates those moneys to the Governor's Office of Information Technology to perform the programming work for the Department of Revenue. The clause also provides an appropriation of \$5,920 cash funds from the License Plate Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles for FY 2014-15 for the purchase of the special license plates from the Department of Corrections, Correctional Industries.
