

UPDATED SUMMARY
SENATE BILL 14-036

Second Regular Session - Sixty-ninth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

The bill creates the EMS license plate. A person becomes eligible to use the plate by providing a certificate confirming that the person made a \$25 donation to the emergency medical services association of Colorado. In addition to the standard motor vehicle fees, the plate requires 2 one-time fees of \$25. One of the fees is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other to the licensing services cash fund. *\$4,120 and \$5,920 are appropriated to the department of revenue for implementation.*
