A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING AUTHORIZING SHARING INFORMATION BETWEEN STATE**
102 **AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES RELATED TO LEGAL**
103 **MARIJUANA.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. For retail marijuana licensing purposes, the bill allows a local jurisdiction to submit fingerprints for purposes of conducting a criminal history background check or to acquire a name-based criminal history check if the licensee's fingerprints are unclassifiable.

Capital letters indicate new material to be added to existing statute.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-306, **amend**
3 (2) (c) as follows:

4 **12-43.4-306. Persons prohibited as licensees - definitions.**

5 (2) (c) At the time of filing an application for issuance of a state retail
6 marijuana establishment license, an applicant shall submit a set of his or
7 her fingerprints and file personal history information concerning the
8 applicant's qualifications for a state license on forms prepared by the state
9 licensing authority. The state licensing authority ~~OR LOCAL JURISDICTION~~
10 shall submit the fingerprints ~~and the local jurisdiction may forward~~
11 ~~fingerprints~~ to the Colorado bureau of investigation for the purpose of
12 conducting fingerprint-based criminal history record checks. The
13 Colorado bureau of investigation shall forward the fingerprints to the
14 federal bureau of investigation for the purpose of conducting
15 fingerprint-based criminal history record checks. The state licensing
16 authority ~~OR LOCAL JURISDICTION~~ may acquire a name-based criminal
17 history record check for an applicant or a license holder who has twice
18 submitted to a fingerprint-based criminal history record check and whose
19 fingerprints are unclassifiable. An applicant who has previously
20 submitted fingerprints for state ~~OR LOCAL~~ licensing purposes may request
21 that the fingerprints on file be used. The state licensing authority ~~OR~~
22 ~~LOCAL JURISDICTION~~ shall use the information resulting from the
23 fingerprint-based criminal history record check to investigate and
24 determine whether an applicant is qualified to hold a state ~~OR LOCAL~~
25 license pursuant to this article. The state ~~LICENSING AUTHORITY~~ or local
26 ~~licensing authority~~ ~~JURISDICTION~~ may verify any of the information an

1 applicant is required to submit.

2 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
3 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
4 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
