A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF JUDGES FOR THE
102 EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Bill Summary

The bill increases the number of judges for the 18th judicial district from 21 to 23.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-5-119, **add** (2) (d)
2 (V) as follows:

3 **13-5-119. Eighteenth district.** (2) (d) (V) SUBJECT TO
4 AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014, THE NUMBER OF
5 JUDGES FOR THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT IS TWENTY-THREE.

6 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
7 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
8 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
