- 16 AND ORAL HEALTH COVERAGE THROUGH THE MEDICAID OR THE OLD AGE
- 17 PENSION HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE FUND.
- (b) If an eligible senior does not qualify or apply for
- 19 DENTAL AND ORAL HEALTH COVERAGE THROUGH THESE PROGRAMS, THE
- 20 QUALIFIED GRANTEE MAY CONTINUE TO PROVIDE SERVICES UNDER THIS
- 21 ARTICLE; EXCEPT THAT, AFTER FEBRUARY 28, 2015, SERVICES MAY BE
- 22 PROVIDED ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT THE SERVICES WERE PART OF A
- 23 TREATMENT PLAN ESTABLISHED PRIOR TO FEBRUARY 28, 2015.".
