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A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE AMOUNT OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE FEE THAT A RURAL COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER MAY RETAIN WHEN ISSUING A DRIVER'S LICENSE, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING

104 AND REDUCING APPROPRIATIONS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Currently, a county clerk and recorder's office that issues a driver's license may retain \$8 of the fee. The bill allows the office to retain \$13.60

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-114, **amend** (4); 3 and repeal and reenact, with amendments, (2) as follows: 4 **42-2-114.** License issued - fees. (2) (a) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN 5 SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION, THE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A 6 DRIVER'S LICENSE TO A PERSON TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER IS 7 TWENTY DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS. THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE 8 APPLICANT'S BIRTHDAY IN THE FIFTH YEAR AFTER ISSUANCE OF THE 9 LICENSE. 10 (b) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER THE FEE TO THE STATE 11 TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT FIFTEEN DOLLARS TO THE HIGHWAY 12 USERS TAX FUND, CREATED IN SECTION 43-4-201, C.R.S., AND FIVE 13 DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS TO THE LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND, 14 CREATED IN SECTION 42-2-114.5; EXCEPT THAT, THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 15 2014-15, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT THE ENTIRE FEE TO THE 16 LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND. 17 (c) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2): 18 (I) IF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE IS ISSUED BY THE OFFICE OF A COUNTY 19 CLERK AND RECORDER IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF AT LEAST ONE 20 HUNDRED THOUSAND INDIVIDUALS, THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER 21 SHALL RETAIN THE SUM OF EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORWARD THE 22 REMAINDER TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSMISSION TO THE STATE 23 TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THREE DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS TO 24 THE LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND AND NINE DOLLARS TO THE HIGHWAY 25 USERS TAX FUND; EXCEPT THAT, THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2014-15, THE

3	(II) IF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE IS ISSUED BY AN OFFICE OF A COUNTY

7	CENTS AND FORWARD THE REMAINDER TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR
8	TRANSMISSION TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT ONE
9	DOLLAR AND EIGHTY-SIX CENTS TO THE LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND
10	AND FOUR DOLLARS AND NINETY-FOUR CENTS TO THE HIGHWAY USERS
11	TAX FUND; EXCEPT THAT, THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2014-15, THE STATE
12	TREASURER SHALL CREDIT THE ENTIRE FEE TO THE LICENSING SERVICES

14	(d) In addition to the fee established in paragraph (a) of
15	THIS SUBSECTION (2), A SURCHARGE OF TWO DOLLARS IS ADDED FOR
16	ISSUANCE OF A DRIVER'S OR PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE WITH A
17	MOTORCYCLE ENDORSEMENT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER THE
18	SURCHARGE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT IT TO THE
19	MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR SAFETY TRAINING FUND, CREATED IN SECTION
20	43-5-504, C.R.S.
21	(e) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FROM
22	THE LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE
23	Administration of this part 1 and part 2 of this article; except
24	THAT:
25	(I) EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS OF EACH FEE IS ALLOCATED
26	IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 43-4-205 (6) (b), C.R.S.; AND
27	(II) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH

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1	(e), THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2014-15, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT

3	(4) (a) (I) The fee for the issuance of a minor driver's license is
4	twenty dollars and forty cents. which THE license expires twenty days
5	after the LICENSEE'S twenty-first birthday. of the licensee.
6	(II) The department shall transfer the fee to the state treasurer,
7	who shall credit fifteen dollars to the highway users tax fund and five
8	dollars and forty cents to the licensing services cash fund, created in
9	section 42-2-114.5; except that, for fiscal years 2012-13 through 2014-15,
10	the state treasurer shall credit the fee to the licensing services cash fund
11	created in section 42-2-114.5.
12	(III) In the case of the issuance of any minor driver's license by
13	the office of the A county clerk and recorder, the fee for the minor driver's
14	license is apportioned in the same manner as for the issuance of a driver's
15	license in accordance with paragraph (a) (c) of subsection (2) of this
16	section.
17	(b) (I) Prior to July 1, 2006, a surcharge of one dollar shall be
18	added for issuance of a minor driver's license for which a motorcycle
19	endorsement is requested which shall be credited to the motorcycle
20	operator safety training fund created in section 43-5-504, C.R.S.
21	(II) On and after July 1, 2006, A surcharge of two dollars shall be
22	added for issuance of a minor driver's license for which a motorcycle
23	endorsement is requested. which The Surcharge shall be credited to the
24	motorcycle operator safety training fund, created in section 43-5-504
25	C.R.S.
26	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-5-504, amend (1)
27	as follows:

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43-5-504. Motorcycle operator safety training fund. (1) The motorcycle operator safety training fund is hereby created in the state treasury. The fund consists of moneys collected under sections 42-2-114 (2) (b) (d) and (4) (b), 42-2-118 (1) (b) (II), and 42-3-304 (4), C.R.S. The moneys in the fund are available immediately, without further appropriation, for allocation by the transportation commission to the office to be used for the implementation and administration of the program. Moneys credited to the fund remain therein IN THE FUND at the end of each fiscal year and are not transferred to any other fund.

SECTION 3. Appropriation - adjustments to 2014 long bill.

(1) For the implementation of this act, the general fund appropriation made in the annual general appropriation act to the controlled maintenance trust fund created in section 24-75-302.5 (2) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, is decreased by \$61,264.

- (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of revenue, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$61,264, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be allocated to the division of motor vehicles, driver services, for personal services related to the implementation of this act.
- (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado state titling and registration account of the highway users tax fund created in section 42-1-211 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of revenue, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$6,592, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be allocated

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for the purchase of computer center services for the implementation of this act.

(4) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and budgeting, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$6,592, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the office of information technology, for the provision of computer center services for the department of revenue related to the implementation of this act. Said sum is from reappropriated funds received from the department of revenue out of the appropriation made in subsection (3) of this section.

SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date - applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

(2) This act applies to driver's licenses issued on or after the applicable effective date of this act.

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
