THE STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL 17 PROVIDE A COPY OF THE REPORT TO THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEES OF THE 18 SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, OR ANY SUCCESSOR 19 COMMITTEES, ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2016. 20 (2) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2017.".
