After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB14-177 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 12, strike "that" and substitute "that ONLY
2 WHEN THAT ACT OR OMISSION".

3 Page 4, line 4, after "AND" insert "ONLY".

4 Page 4, after line 21 insert:

5 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 26-1-140 as
6 follows:

7 **26-1-140. Drug-endangered child definition - effect of**
8 **legislation review - repeal.** (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2016, THE
9 STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVIEW AND PREPARE A REPORT ON THE
10 EFFECT AND OUTCOMES OF SENATE BILL 14-177, ENACTED IN 2014, FROM
11 AUGUST 1, 2014, THROUGH AUGUST 1, 2016. THE REVIEW MUST INCLUDE
12 THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN REMOVED FROM THE HOME BASED ON THE
13 DEFINITION OF A DRUG-ENDANGERED CHILD IN SECTION 19-1-103 (44.7),
14 C.R.S., AND ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE STATE DEPARTMENT DEEMS
15 NECESSARY TO ASSESS THE IMPACT OF SENATE BILL 14-177, ENACTED IN
16 2014, ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES. THE STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL
17 PROVIDE A COPY OF THE REPORT TO THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEES OF THE
18 SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, OR ANY SUCCESSOR
19 COMMITTEES, ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2016.

20 (2) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017.".
