Future Fiscal Impact

Although this bill would not affect appropriations to the Department of Corrections for FY 2014-15, it is projected to <u>reduce</u> the Department's operating expenses by a total of \$7.3 million General Fund from FY 2015-16 through FY 2018-19 [see the table on page 4 of the attached Revised Fiscal Note].
