General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2014-15 based on the March 2014 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package allocates all but approximately \$7.5 million of General Fund revenues projected to be available. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2014-15 budget package the \$131.1 million General Fund required by this bill to increase the statutory reserve from 5.0 percent to 6.5 percent.
