Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2014-15 based on the March 2014 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package allocates all but approximately \$7.9 million of General Fund revenues projected to be available. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2014-15 budget package a \$599,264 General Fund appropriation for implementation of this bill.
