<u>SB14-138</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-21-113.7, amend
4 (1); and add (2) (e) and (4) as follows:

5 13-21-113.7. Immunity of volunteer firefighters, volunteers, 6 incident management teams, and their employers or organizations -7 definitions - legislative declaration. (1) A volunteer firefighter OR 8 VOLUNTEER who, in good faith, takes part in firefighting efforts or 9 provides emergency care, rescue, assistance, or recovery services at the 10 scene of an emergency, any incident management team, and any person 11 who, in good faith, commands, directs, employs, sponsors, or represents 12 any such volunteer firefighter, VOLUNTEER, or incident management team 13 shall not be liable for civil damages as a result of an act or omission by 14 such volunteer firefighter, VOLUNTEER, incident management team, or 15 other person in connection with the emergency; except that this 16 exemption shall not apply to grossly negligent, willful, wanton, or 17 reckless acts or omissions.

(2) As used in this section:

19 (e) "VOLUNTEER" HAS THE MEANING AS SET FORTH IN SECTION20 13-21-115.5.

21 (4) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION ALTERS THE PROTECTIONS SET
22 FORTH IN SECTIONS 12-64-118, 13-21-108, 13-21-115.5, OR 24-33.5-1505,
23 C.R.S.

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SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 2 3

preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".

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
