13	(b) THE AIRCRAFT WILL REMAIN IN THE STATE ONLY FOR THE
14	PURPOSE OF FINAL ASSEMBLY, MAINTENANCE, MODIFICATION, OR
15	COMPLETION;
16	(c) THE AIRCRAFT WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE STATE WITHIN ONE
17	HUNDRED TWENTY DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE SALE; AND
18	(d) THE AIRCRAFT WILL NOT BE IN THE STATE MORE THAN
19	SEVENTY-THREE DAYS IN ANY OF THE THREE CALENDAR YEARS
20	FOLLOWING THE CALENDAR YEAR IN WHICH THE AIRCRAFT IS REMOVED

(3) AN AIRCRAFT THAT IS HANGARED OR PARKED OVERNIGHT SHALL BE CONSIDERED TO BE IN THE STATE FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2014. **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".

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
