Summary of Legislation

Recommended by the **Joint Budget Committee**, this bill makes three FY 2014-15 transfers to the Capital Construction Fund (CCF), from several sources.

State Transfers

For FY 2014-15, the bill transfers \$221,493,465 to the CCF for 63 state-funded capital construction and controlled maintenance projects listed in the 2014 Long Bill, House Bill 14-1336, including \$219,993,465 from the General Fund, \$1,000,000 from the State Historical Fund, and \$500,000 from the General Fund Exempt account.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
