A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE REINSTATEMENT OF THE AUTHORITY FOR ACTIVE**
102 **MILITARY PERSONNEL TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONALLY.**

Bill Summary

The bill requires the director of the division of registrations in the department of regulatory agencies to reinstate the expired license, certificate, or registration of any active military personnel pursuant to specific requirements.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-102, **amend**
3 (8) (d) introductory portion as follows:

4 **24-34-102. Division of professions and occupations - creation**
5 **- duties of division and department heads - license renewal,**
6 **reinstatement, and endorsement - definitions - rules - review of**
7 **functions - repeal.** (8) (d) **Reinstatement.** A licensee, registrant, or
8 certificate holder who does not renew his or her license, registration, or
9 certificate within the sixty-day grace period pursuant to paragraph (c) of
10 this subsection (8) shall be treated as having an expired license,
11 registration, or certificate and shall be ineligible to practice until such
12 license, registration, or certificate is reinstated. THE DIRECTOR, LICENSING
13 BOARD, OR COMMISSION SHALL REINSTATE THE EXPIRED LICENSE,
14 CERTIFICATE, OR REGISTRATION OF ANY ACTIVE MILITARY PERSONNEL IF
15 THE MILITARY PERSONNEL MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PARAGRAPH
16 (d). An expired license, registration, or certificate OF ANY OTHER PERSON
17 may be reinstated at the discretion and pursuant to the authority of the
18 director, licensing board, or commission pursuant to the following
19 requirements:

20 **SECTION 2. Applicability.** This act applies to licenses,
21 certificates, and registrations that are expired on or after the effective date
22 of this act.

23 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
24 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
25 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
