After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

<u>HB14-1126</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add part 2 to article 1.5 of title 12 as follows: 4 5 PART 2 6 BREAST DENSITY NOTIFICATION 7 12-1.5-201. Mammogram report - dense breasts - required 8 **notice - definition.** (1) EACH PERSON WHO IS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. 9 SEC. 263b TO PROVIDE A PATIENT, THE PATIENT'S PHYSICIAN, OR MEDICAL 10 INSTITUTION WITH A MAMMOGRAM REPORT AND WHO HAS DETERMINED 11 THAT THE PATIENT HAS DENSE BREAST TISSUE, AS DETERMINED BY THE 12 INTERPRETING PHYSICIAN BASED ON STANDARDS PROMULGATED BY THE 13 AMERICAN COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY, SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING 14 NOTICE WITH THE MAMMOGRAM REPORT: 15 YOUR MAMMOGRAM SHOWS THAT YOUR BREAST TISSUE IS 16 DENSE. DENSE BREAST TISSUE IS COMMON AND IS NOT 17 ABNORMAL. HOWEVER, DENSE BREAST TISSUE CAN MAKE IT 18 HARDER TO EVALUATE THE RESULTS OF YOUR MAMMOGRAM 19 AND MAY ALSO BE ASSOCIATED WITH AN INCREASED RISK OF 20 BREAST CANCER. THIS INFORMATION ABOUT THE RESULTS 21 OF YOUR MAMMOGRAM IS GIVEN TO YOU TO RAISE YOUR 22 AWARENESS AND TO INFORM YOUR CONVERSATIONS WITH 23 YOUR DOCTOR. TOGETHER, YOU CAN DECIDE WHICH

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1 SCREENING OPTIONS ARE RIGHT FOR YOU. A REPORT OF

2 YOUR RESULTS WAS SENT TO YOUR PHYSICIAN.

3 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THIS SECTION DOES NOT
4 CREATE A CAUSE OF ACTION OR CREATE A STANDARD OF CARE,
5 OBLIGATION, OR DUTY THAT PROVIDES A BASIS FOR A CAUSE OF ACTION.

6 **SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2014.

7 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

8 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

9 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".

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
