**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$7,500 cash funds from the Prescription Drug Monitoring Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies.

Please note that both H.B. 14-1283 and H.B. 14-1173 require an appropriation of \$7,500 for the same vendor modifications to the PDMP database. The appropriations amendment prepared for H.B. 14-1173 makes the appropriation of \$7,500 cash funds to DORA contingent on H.B. 14-1283 not becoming law to ensure that DORA does not receive duplicative appropriations if both bills are enacted. **Therefore, amendment J.001 should be adopted.**
